Report of Conference

Introduction

Prof. Dr. N. D. Patil Mahavidyalaya Malkapur belongs to Kolhapur district which is historically significant part of Western Maharashtra. Kolhapur is known for its forts, palaces and historical monuments. Since Malkapur is near Vishalgadh and Pawankhind, the department of history has a special responsibility to preserve the historical heritage of this region. Taking these aspects into account, the department of history has taken an initiative in this regard and held a 'Shivaji University History Conference' on 14th and 15th February 2015.

Objectives of the conference:

1. To introduce new trends in historiography research scholars, academicians and students.
2. To study and understand the History of Konkan.
3. To promote the writing the local history in view of ancient, medieval and modern period.
4. To convey the significance of historical sources.

Details of the Conference:

Shivaji University History Conference was organized in our college on 14th and 15th February 2015. This conference was inaugurated by Hon. Chhatrapati Sambhajiraje. In his speech, he quoted 'History teaches us how to lead our life.' He focused on the Maratha History. On the first day, Dr. Kishore Bedakihal expressed his views regarding the influence of the European Nazi and Fascist ideologies on V. D. Savarkar's concept of nationalism and *Hindu Nation*. As many as 106 researchers including students participated in this conference from the various parts of Maharashtra. Of these participants, 72 researchers presented their research papers on various topics mentioned in the theme of the conference such as local history, Maratha History, History of Konkan, as well as various topics of Indian History. The special lectures of renowned historians such as Dr. Kishore Bedkihal,

Prof. Arun Bhonsale, Prof. Dr. Chandrakant Abhang, Prof. Madhav Patil were organized. This conference changed the outlook of the participants to look at the local history writing. In the lecture Series organized in the memory of Late Prof. A. R. Kulkarni, Dr. Chandrakant Abhang highlighted the causes of rise and downfall of Maratha power in Rajsthan and Madhya Pradesh.

2. The conference created the awareness of importance of Local history.
3. It promoted the writing the local history in view of ancient, medieval and modern period.

Ecosystem is a self-contained community of micro-organisms, animals and plants that interact with each other and with their physical environment. 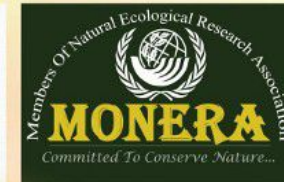

It is located in the Sahyadri Ranges of the Western Ghats of Maharashtra, and is a part of North Western Ghats moist deciduous forests and North Western Ghats montane rain forests. These ranges form a common boundary between Maharashtra, Karnataka and Goa, and constitute rich evergreen, semi-evergreen and moist deciduous forests. The area is spread over four districts, namely Satara (Mahabaleshwar, Medha, Satara and Patan Tehsil), Sangli (Shirala Tehsil), Kolhapur (Shahuwadi Tehsil) and Ratnagiri (Sangameshwar, Chiplun and Khed Tehsil). This Tiger reserve is mainly composed of three UNESCO World Heritage Sites –Chandoli, National Park, Koyna, Wildlife Sanctuary and Radhanagari, Wildlife Sanctuary. The core area of the reserve is 600.12 km² (231.71 sq m.). Buffer Area: 565 km² (218 sq m.) and Total Area: 1,166 km² (450 sq m.). The Tiger reserve is home to many endemic flora and fauna as well as the ruling area of Bengal Tiger.

Amba, has always been a critical part of corridor, the forest cover is depleting day by day due to human pressures.
